The following Fees will apply for the 2020-21 season:

- Full Member = £140 (if Registered BEFORE 31st of July 2020). Registration after 1st of August 2020 = £150;
- Training ONLY Member = £100;
- Cubs (U6) = £80

All members will be invoiced via Teamer (U7 and above must pay within 2 weeks of receiving the invoice). Cubs will be invoiced around November 2020. If joining after 1st of January 2021; all fees will be halved for the season, no new members can be registered after 15th of February 2021. NO OTHER DISCOUNTED RATE IS AVAILABLE.

All members (except Cubs) MUST buy their own club playing kit; this kit is available from the Club official kit and merchandising supplier KS Teamwear and you MUST order the "Official Old Windsor Tigers 2020/21 Player Kit Bundle (Red/Black 'home' kit)" from below link:-

Please speak to your Team Coach/Manager before placing any order as you will need to find out your players squad number (do NOT order without checking - as duplicate squad numbers within a Team will have to be replaced at extra cost to yourself).

These forms will initially be held by the coach/manager and then passed onto the Club Secretary for safe keeping until end of season and will be destroyed on 1st of July 2021.

This form covers all aspects of GDPR as well as the Club Medical Consent Form and Media Consent Form (and by signing it you 'Opt-In' to all forms of communication from the Club, FA and League).

I give consent for OWTFC to contact us via e-mail, text and/or post using 3rd party products and to hold the data provided on the Player Registration Form 2020-21 to use for its own purposes. Also, if required, I give consent for my data to be shared with the FA and/or appropriate League and loaded into their systems to enable my player to play league/cup games. All data held at OWTFC will be destroyed/deleted on 1st of July 2021.

If a player receives a Yellow and/or Red card during the season, the FA and/or League may implement a financial penalty on that player sent to the Club (currently £12 for Yellow & £35 for Red). This fee will be passed onto the player. The player is also liable for any late fees (£3) for failing to respond or pay the caution within 14 days. The player must also serve any FA match ban implemented and will not be able to resume playing for OWTFC until the ban is served and the fine is paid back to the Club.

In accordance with Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) Regulations and Procedures regarding the use of photography at sporting events, involving individuals under the age of 18, OWTFC seek approval from all parents/ guardians and those players selected to represent the club, for the limited use of photography during match-day and associated activities. Photos will only be taken of individuals in action, during matches or training and as squad shots, none will be taken of persons within the dressing room areas or if unaccompanied at any time.

I am in agreement that those in charge may give my player medical treatment in an emergency and we undertake to inform the coach/manager of any changes in fitness/health of the player during the season.

I accept full financial responsibility if the player incurs any costs due to inappropriate behaviour.

If my player is selected to play we will be able to attend matches that are played either on Saturday, Sunday or mid-week and also abide by rules set out by: OWTFC, The FA, BBFA (Bucks and Berks FA) and EBFA (East Berks FA).

OWTFC supports "The FA Respect Code-of-Conduct" programme and by agreeing to join the Club you and your player agree to abide by these same guidelines as set out for 'Spectators & Parents', 'Young Players' and 'FA Equality Policy' documents. Please read these documents before completing this form as non-compliance will result in disciplinary action being taken against you or your player.
